


It is the policy of Aiken Technical College to seek, accept, and administer external funds, gifts, and grants that will be used to further the College's mission, purpose, and strategic plan. The College may seek and accept these funds, gifts, and grants from public and private sources, including other governmental agencies, individuals, foundations, organizations, corporations, and businesses.

External funds, gifts, and grants received by the College will be administered in compliance with applicable laws, regulations, donor restrictions, and other requirements. Solicitation and acceptance of all gifts will be coordinated through the Director of Resource Development. Solicitation and acceptance of all grants will be coordinated through the Grants Coordinator.

The President or authorized designee will accept funds, gifts, and grants directly to the institution or refer the donor of any funds, gifts, and grants to the Aiken Technical College Foundation for consideration of acceptance. The ATC Foundation is an independent, non-profit, tax-exempt organization established to obtain resources that support the College's mission, goals, objectives, and educational philosophy.
